Based on the Accrediting Commission for Schools, Western Association of Schools and Colleges (ACS WASC) mid-cycle visit, it has been determined that AeroSTEM Academy (5-12) meets the ACS WASC criteria for accreditation. This accreditation status is based on all of the information provided by the school, including the school's progress report, and the satisfactory completion of the mid-cycle accreditation visit.

AeroSTEM Academy's accreditation is now reaffirmed through the end of the current accreditation cycle ending on June 30, 2028. Your school's accreditation is contingent upon the submission of a follow-up progress report focusing on the growth areas for continuous improvement and any new areas of concern, if applicable, identified in the visiting committee report. The follow-up progress report is due to the ACS WASC office by June 1, 2026.

Accreditation status is conditioned upon AeroSTEM Academy's continued adherence with the ACS WASC policies, procedures, and criteria for accreditation. This includes a requirement that an accredited school annually contribute members to participate on visiting committees. Failure to maintain compliance with said policies, procedures, and standards is grounds for modification and/or withdrawal of the accreditation.

The Commission looks forward to AeroSTEM Academy's anticipated success and continuing improvement in keeping with ACS WASC's pursuit of excellence in elementary, secondary, and adult education.
